IX. NEW BUSINESS

A. Music Director's Report

Class starts on the filed Monday - Friday at 7:10 am

Please talk with your child on the importance of being on time; tardies are still very much a thing, all students need to be on time.

It is also important to take note that Marching band students and Color guard students that participate in zero block do receive their Gym requirement. Our first performance gig will take place on:

August 22, 2024 - D124 Back to School Bash at 6:00 p.m. At Central Middle School blacktop

Students are to arrive at 5:45 p.m. and should be done by 6:45 p.m. No buses will be provided and students are required to secure their own transportation to and from. Students are to be in their Class B Uniform ("Music Changes Lives" shirt) Black bottoms and DrillMaster shoes. Students should also be aware that they are required to learn the different band uniform requirements.

For example:

Class B - Uniform - EP Green "Music Changes Lives" T-shirts and Black bottoms with black socks and their DrillMasters (shoes) if they have them. If they do not then all Black shoes are acceptable.

Class A - Uniform - The full band uniform. Jacket, Bibbers, DrillMasters, Shakos and black socks. Black socks are an important part of the Band uniform; Please make sure that your Kid has the proper amount of Black socks needed for their Band performance year.

It is important to take note that if your Kiddo is not properly prepared with their band uniform requirements, the team as a whole does get points deducted during their band competitions.

Please try to purchase a show shirt for your kiddo this year, it is not required but the Show shirt is recommended for them to wear underneath their Class A uniform when we travel for competitions. Last day to purchase a Show shirt for this performance year is August 16, 2024; A link to order can be found in Skyward and in our Google calendar.

Sectionals

Are held every Wednesday (during marching season) from 6:30 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. If your student has a school related event (game) they can be excused from the required sectional for that week.

Puffs

Puffs is the last official play that I will be directing with EPCHS before retirement. Auditions will be held on Sunday, August 18th at 6:30 p.m. in the school auditorium. Once the cast list is released, practices will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 6:30 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. A few weekend practices might be held closer to the event date but that will be announced at a later time. Auditions for our Second play (Cinderella) of the School year will be held in December; Show to be performed during the Spring of 2025.

Final remarks; Upcoming information and current grades for Band can be found in Skyward. Please remind your kiddos that participation in Class counts towards their Band grade and encourage your kid to practice at home. Standing in front of a full-length

mirror marching with their instrument may sound off but it will help them build security and confidence in their marching ability. B. Choir Director's Report

We're off to a great start, It's been great jumping into a well established program full of kids that are involved in band, choir and Scholastic Bowl. I grew up in Sandwich, IL and went to Sandwich High School which is not far from here. Being from a musical community similar in size I'm excited to be giving back and sharing my experiences from my own background. At the moment our Choir students have a lot less going on than Band, but are busy at work building our skills before we start our concert season. We have a handful of kids that were not signed up for Lunch choir that still came in to check things out. So if your kiddo is still thinking about signing up we encourage that, they have till tomorrow to officially add them to the schedule.

The nice thing about Choir is that we're always looking to build that skill set if they're interested. Upcoming things that we have going on are working with the Lunch Choir. Kids give up their lunch period to come in and sing, please give them my congratulations for coming in and giving up their time. We have a handful of kiddos that come in during their class Choir time and lunch choir. Class choir (35 minutes during 2 Lunch choir periods) is focused on building skills, sight reading, learning about music literacy and working on their vocal technique.

We have Madrigals auditions coming up, Madrigals is a group of 12 to 20 students that perform a musical styling of the renaissance period. This small vocal ensemble performs acapella and is generally centered during the holiday season. This is more of a challenging group of students that get to push their skill set a bit further. The video Auditions are to be submitted this coming Thursday 8/22 in google classroom. Madrigal rehearsals are held on Monday's sometime in the evening generally from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. First rehearsal will be held on Monday 8/26.

Later on in the year around Spring time Madrigals will turn into the "Unaccompanied Minors" Acapella group. It will be required for students to resubmit New auditions for Unaccompanied Minors. Choir events coming up are as follows:

- Veterans day breakfast performance at EPCHS 7:30 a.m. November 7th
- November 10th Sunday 3:00 p.m. Musical theater concert "Be the Hero"

Reminders will be given to your kiddos on all this information, and upcoming auditions. Please encourage them to check Google classroom on a Daily basis. Please encourage your kiddos to sing. Any questions please feel free to email me, I check emails a few times a day.

C. Color Guard Coach Report

It is understood that every assignment Band has the Color guard also has as well as Sectional practice on Wednesdays.

D. <u>U Of I Performance : September 7, 2024</u>

This is **NOT** a free event for parents and spectators but our Students perform on the field of U of I with 400 other students from around the state of Illinois along with the Fighting Illini Marching Band and color guard. **This is a Class A Uniform required event.** The performance takes place during Half time and Tickets are available now for purchase. Tickets are available to purchase through the link on The EPCHS Band Website. This will be a sold out event, U of I is set to play against Kansas. Therefore, it is not recommended to wait to purchase tickets if you'd like to attend. This is also a cashless event, if you do not plan on attending please make sure that your kid has the availability to access cash electronically to purchase any food or merch that they would like to have. Evergreen Park Music Boosters (volunteers sign up to follow) will provide water and some snacks for the kids but they will have to provide their own meal. It is recommended for them to bring lunch from home, please be aware that this will be a full day event. We will leave EPHS around 11 a.m. and return past midnight.

E. <u>Car Wash Fundraiser: September 14, 2024</u> **Rain date 9/15/2024**

The Car wash fundraiser is one of the largest fundraisers that is held by the Music Department with the help of the Music Boosters. ALL of the proceeds raised by this event go directly back to the students who work the event. 100% of the proceeds raised will benefit the students who will travel with The EPCHS Music department on their trip year. The projected trip for the 2026 calendar year is Disney World. Pledge sheets for students who sign up will be sent home prior to Labor Day weekend. The students have 2 weeks to collect their pledges towards the Car Wash.

All of the monetary donations collected the day of the Car Wash will be evenly distributed amongst all of the Music department students who sign up to work the event. The event usually runs from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
