

We are always looking for parents to help at school events to support our music students. Here are some upcoming volunteer and donation opportunities!


October 13 is the 1st Band Competition in Marengo - we need volunteers to help load the truck and as well as snack/water donations:

We've got the thing for you!


Our annual fundraiser for Winter Wreaths has begun.


Order forms went out to students this past Wednesday, October 2nd. They will be due with payment on Thursday, October 17th.


A few cool reasons you should come see the show...
